-  DTE does not have a realistic carbon neutrality plan⁴



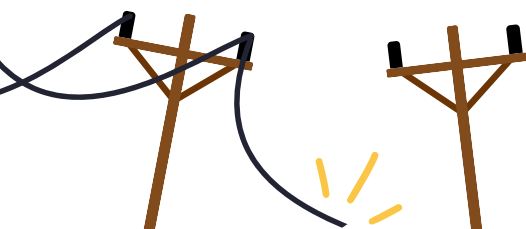

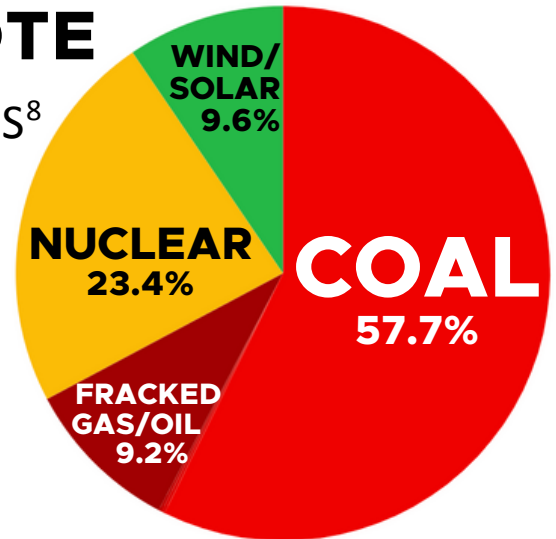
