

REPLACE DTE with a public electric utility!

- Only public power utilities have reached 100% renewable power¹
- With a public power utility we decide how to produce our energy
- Public utilities have much fewer and shorter electricity outages²
- Public utilities can make rooftop solar easier for residents
- DTE burns 67% fossil fuels to produce our electricity³
- DTE does not have a realistic carbon neutrality plan⁴

During the March 2023 outages, DTE bragged at a shareholder meeting that it was deferring badly needed maintenance to increase profits.⁷






We can do better than DTE
